Parish Priest's Corner Surgery Thursday 14th January 4-6pm

A plenary indulgence can be gained only once a day during the Year of Mercy. In order to obtain it, you must, in addition to being in the state of grace: have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin; have sacramentally confessed your sins; receive the Holy Eucharist, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, an Our Father and a Hail Mary are suggested. One sacramental Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the Holy Father's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence. Indulgences can always be applied either to yourself or to the souls of the deceased, but they cannot be applied to other persons living on earth.
